New “Humans of Franklin” Series Creates a Living Scrapbook of Resident Stories

FRANKLIN, WI – Beginning September, Franklin Public Library will feature one library patron on its website and Facebook page every Monday as part of their new “Humans of Franklin” series. Using snapshot portraits and stories, the program aims to create a scrapbook of the people who live, work, and play in Franklin.



“Everyone has a story to tell,” said Caitlin Sprague, Programming & Outreach Coordinator at Franklin Public Library. “Franklin is a wonderfully diverse city, and through ‘Humans of Franklin’ we have the opportunity to connect through our shared experiences and learn from one another. We are all unique in our own way, but we are also all human.”

Every Monday a photograph of one library patron will be published online accompanied by a quote from that person. Quotes range in topic from aspirations to challenges, to hobbies, philosophies, and advice.

The program is an offshoot of the popular “Humans of New York” blog, in which renowned photojournalist Brandon Stanton interviews everyday people on the streets of New York City.

“We’re the perfect site for collecting stories,” said Sprague. Franklin Public Library serves a wide range of patrons across all demographics. Programs and services are offered free of charge to anyone who walks through its doors, and it shares many of its resources with other Milwaukee County Libraries.
